FUHR and RHODEN TIE for FIRST

It wasn't just the attendance that was on pace to set a record at The American Century Championship. The record, for a round, was broken by Grant Fuhr who shot a Stableford score of +32. The previous record +31 was held by the 2007 champion, Chris Chandler. Fuhr added to his first day total of +24 to finish with a two-day score of +56.

Rick Rhoden had a combined two-day score of +56 via a +25 on Friday and today's +31.

Tony Romo, the first day leader with a score of +27, ended Saturday's play with a +22 to fall into a tie for third.

Dan Quinn, the 2004 winner, gained the third place-tie with Romo with a +21 Friday and +28 Saturday (+49).

Also in striking distance is San Jose Shark Jeremy Roenick, with a +47.

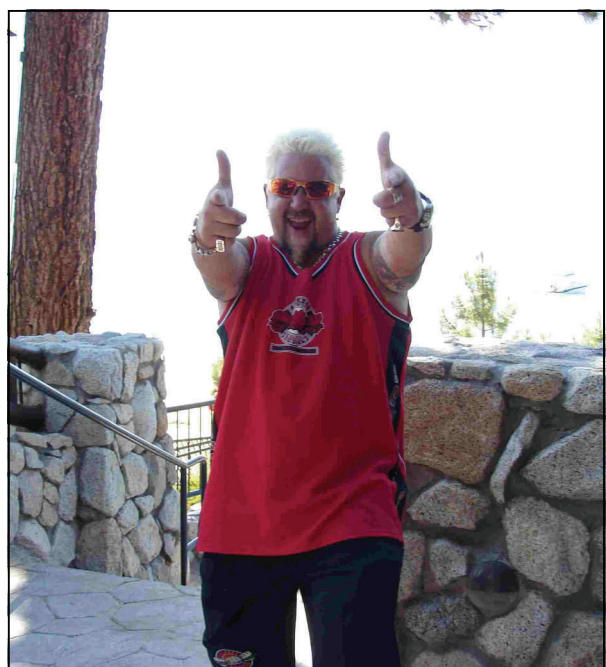
