**Jeremy Roenick and Jack Wagner tie for First  
Alfonso Ribeiro wins the Korbels Long-Drive Competition**

First day leaders, Jack Wagner, left, and Jeremy Roenick answer questions from the media on their first round play. Wagner, singer and actor, and former NHL 20-year great Roenick, were tied for the lead with 26 Stableford points.

The Stableford scoring system awards positive points for good play and negative points for bad play. The golfer with the highest score wins.

A Double Bogey = minus 2 pts;  
Bogey = 0 pts; Par is +1 pt;  
Birdie = +3 pts; Eagle = +6 pts.  
A Hole-in-One is worth +8 pts  
and a Double Eagle is +10 pts.
