Billy Joe Tolliver gains huge lead with record-setting day.

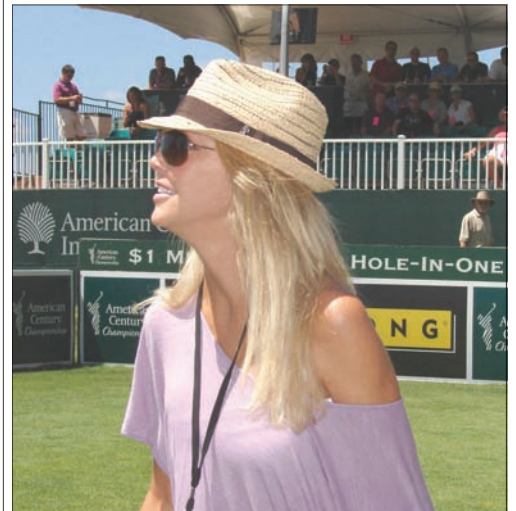
