

JACKSON HOLE HAS MORE THIS WINTER with FLIGHTS, NEW QUAD and 2X GOLDEN TICKET

TETON VILLAGE, WY – Between snow and visitor totals, Jackson Hole Mountain Resort’s (JHMR) 2018-19 season was one for the record books. The resort’s 715,000 skier visits marks the highest in their history, no doubt due in part to the resort reporting above average snow totals at all elevations, all season. The highlight was the record-setting February snowfall of 193 inches that accumulated in Rendezvous Bowl. The winter closed out at 505 inches for a truly memorable season. Base area snow depths were at record levels from late February through the end of March, making for the best top-to-bottom, wall-to-wall skiing in North America. This was the third season in a row that JHMR topped out above 500 inches of snowfall. Jackson Hole prides itself in the snow experience, and though snow equity is preferred, increases to the snowmaking system over the last few years have allowed JHMR to provide an amazing ski product all season long.
