## NO NAME SALOON – PARK CITY'S ICON on MAIN STREET

PARK CITY, UT – Located at 447 Main Street in downtown Park City, No Name Saloon is one of the friendliest, most famous and best bars in all ski towns. Rumor has it that they sell more beer and more buffalo, actually bison, burgers than any establishment in Utah. With no beef burgers on their otherwise varied menu, the buffalo burgers are their most popular dish, and are served with homemade chips. It was once one of Utah's private clubs until the laws changed in 2009. Since then No Name invites everyone to enter and chow down on their world famous buffalo burger and sip a brew from their large selection of local beers, whiskey, spirits and craft cocktails. Hint, all tap beers in Utah are by law maximum of five percent alcohol. Canned or bottled beer may be more or less strong. Enjoy your favorite brew to suit your personal taste.

No Name Saloon has interesting spaces for hanging out, or hosting a group or private event. The first floor bar area is a museum of Park City and Americana artifacts. TV screens, tuned to sports channels, are abundant on every level of the bar. The music from their speaker system is loud and the vibe is louder. This is not the place for an intimate, romantic first date.

### The Spaces of No Name

No Name is a pretty big place. Over time, it has grown to include some unique spaces like the original Main Bar downstairs, the year-round heated rooftop patio and the latest addition of The Loft. If you are out with the family, there is the Annex Burger family dining room next door. You can always find a great place to hang out. Spaces are available for groups and private parties.

### Main Bar

The original building footprint has been a barroom since 1959. Note the arched brick ceiling. The decor has been collected from all over the place and each piece has a unique story. The kitchen and back area were added on in 2007. The kitchen was renovated in 2020.

### Mezzanine

Take a walk through the main bar, and take the stairs on your right leading up to The Loft and Mezzanine. Keep going up the stairs and you will land in the Mezzanine, a cozy little bar that also services the Rooftop. This is a great little place to hangout and chat with

the bartenders when they have a little down time, which is not often. This area was part of the 2007 expansion, which included the Rooftop Patio.

### Year-round Rooftop Patio

Through the back doors of the Mezzanine is the Rooftop Patio, one of the favorite places in Park City. You can hang out here any time thanks to the overhead radiant heaters and the heated floor. Work your way down to the end, and you can get a great view of Historic Main Street.

### The Loft

On your way up the stairs, hang a right on the landing and you are in The Loft. Pull up a seat at the long bar made from up-cycled basketball court floor. Or slip into one of the super cushy booths under the crystal light of the vintage chandeliers. The Loft has lots of TV's; it is a great place to catch a game. It is also the perfect place to host a private event.

Find Annex Burger Next Door because Kids Are People too

Utah's liquor laws prevent anyone under 21 from being in a bar. However, No Name management bought a building next door and have a restaurant license for it. Named Annex Burger, it is the family friendly restaurant and bar side of No Name Saloon. It features the same menu as No Name, including their world famous buffalo burger, with the addition of a kid's menu. Bring the family and kick-back in their newest location.

You need not be 21 to enjoy the menu at the Annex. They have open seating and you do not need a reservation.

If you are looking for a casual place for lunch, après-ski, early or late dinner or just a place to hang out at the bar with your friends, No Name is your Park City place.
